#### Resources needed

- Paper plate
- Colouring pens or pencils
- Scissors
- 1 pencil with eraser on top
- 1 pin
- 1 straw
- · Small piece of card
- Blue tack

#### Instructions for the Weather Vane

You can follow the instructions below or use our video on the 18th of February 2023..

Step 1: Take your paper plate and write North, South, East and West.

Step 2: decorate your plate with weather symbols- e.g. rain clouds, sunshine.

Step 3: Use the pencil to poke through the paper plate, halfway through.

Step 4: Cut out an arrow and feather shape using card.

Step 5: Use the pin poke it through the middle of the straw and attach it to the pencil with the eraser on top. You may want to ask an adult to help you.

Step 6: Slide the cut arrow between the cut ends at one end and repeat with feather shape on the other end.

Step 7: Attach the blue tack to the sharp end of the pencil.

Step 8: Go outdoor and test your wind vane in the wind.

Print out the wind tracking sheet and record your findings.

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




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#### Settlers for peace game

#### Resources needed


- Leaves

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
#### Rain Gauge Activity

#### Equipment Needed

- One large empty plastic bottle
- Sharpie marker
- Ruler
- A grown up with strong scissors and sandpaper




Step 1: Take a clean plastic bottle.




Step 3: Ask an adult to sandpaper both edges.

Step 4: Use a ruler to mark inches on the bottom half with a sharpie.











Step 5: Take the lid off the top of the bottle and recycle it. Place the top half upside down inside the bottle



Step 6: Place the bottle in a safe place in your garden. You can stabilise it with stones.
