Our Women's National Squad are excited to share their stories and for you to find out more about them throughout your journey in this pack.









RAINBOWS & BROWNIES



If you have never played football in a club before, Huddle is the place for you! Huddle is designed for girls aged 5-12 who want a friendly and fun introduction to football. It is a girls' only programme which allows you to learn new skills whilst having fun with your friends and even the chance to make new friends!
