
This activity is designed to utilise your creative skills to make your own origami bouquet.

- Ribbon






What is Origami?

Origami comes from the words ori which means "folding", and kami meaning "paper".

Origami is the Japanese art of paper folding which began in the 7th century when paper was introduced to Japan from China.

There are nine basic origami folds: the valley (or mountain), the pleat, the rabbit ear, the outside reverse, the inside reverse, the crimp, the squash, the sink and the petal.

It is common to fold using a flat surface, but some people like doing it in the air with no tools!


Badge Book Bag Activity

Recycled Guide Handbook Tote








Use template to cut out 2 x Denim pieces 2 x cotton pieces

be 11 x 11cm


Print on A4

and a reel of cotton.


You can either use a sewing machine or by hand.
