- Any non-member who fulfils the awards criteria

THE PROCEDURES

- Nominations can be made by any member of the Council for Wales
- Nominations should be submitted to the Awards Committee, Girlguiding Cymru
- Nominations should be on the appropriate form which can be obtained from Girlguiding Cymru Office or members of the Girlguiding Cymru Awards Committee
- A nominators recommendation must accompany the form
- Supporting letters may be necessary

NOTES AND GUIDELINES

- Nominators should refer to exceptional quality not necessarily length of the service
- Quality rather than quantity of letters is sought and repetition should be avoided where possible.
- "Go" Individuals details report should be included
- Where possible letters should be typed to assist production of Committee papers
